

Experiment in International Living Program

Expectation of Student Return Activity

All scholarship recipients will be expected to complete the following program requirements upon their return from their summer experience of traveling and living abroad with their host family.

1) Previous to the beginning of the new school year, each student is asked to submit a report to the NCWA School Outreach Committee describing the summer experience and the particular cultural impressions that were part of the experience.

It should include:

a) a brief description of the program in the chosen country and the activities offered including travel, language, lectures, community service, etc.

b) the experience of living with the host family.

c) what was learned specifically about any cultural differences or similarities.

d) how this experience has impacted any pre-conceived ideas about global issues and influenced future life choices.

2) *Students are asked to be prepared to describe their experiences to a student group with a possible power point presentation showing photos taken during the program.*

3) *Students are asked to assist in informing and encouraging more students to apply for the program.*

4) *Students will be asked to present their experiences to the NCWA members before one of the lecture series.*
